CLARIFICATION REGARDING HIJJAMA

National Council for Tibb is a body corporate established under section 3 of UAH Act, 1965 to regulate education, to promote and popularize the Unani Ayurvedic System of Medicine, and research in and to provide for the registration of practitioners of those systems of medicine, working under the administrative control of Ministry of National Health Services Regulations & Coordination Islamabad.

- Hijjama is part of syllabus of diploma in Fazil-U-Tibb-Wal-Jarahat. The syllabus have been duly approved and notified in gazette of Pakistan vide S-R-O No. 376 (1) 87 dated 11th May, 1987.
- Hijjama is taught in 2nd year of FTJ Course and detail is available in course book of Meezan-e-Tibb written by Hakeem Muhammad Kabir-Ud-Din.
- According to 33(1) of UAH Act, 1965 privileges of registered practitioners.
 - Privileges of registered practitioners:-
 - (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any law for the time being in force, every registered or listed practitioner shall be entitled:-
 - (a) to hold any appointment as physician or medical officer in any Unani, Ayurvedic or, as the case may be, Homoeopathic dispensary, hospital, infirmary or lying in hospital is supported by or receive a grant from Government or any local authority and <u>treats patients according to the</u> <u>relevant system of medicine</u>, or in any public establishment, body or institution practicing such system,

 In view of above a registered practitioner of Unani System of Medicine is entitled to practice Hijjama.
